I acknowledge the risks and hazards involved in the sport of sailing and agree to assume all risks and hazards associated therewith arising from my participation in any class, activity, race or event (Racing, Education or Social) sponsored by the Black Bear Yacht Racing Association (BBYRA); its officers, directors, committee members, or any duly authorized agent. I agree to indemnify, not sue and hold harmless the BBYRA, its Board members, officers, directors, committee members, and any duly authorized agent, from any damages to my equipment, injuries or sickness including pandemic to me, my family, household members or guests due to my participation in any class, activity, race, or event sponsored by the BBYRA, for which such members, officers, directors, or agents are acting or have acted in an organizational, management, or coordination role.

I agree to abide by all of the rules and regulations (referenced, printed and verbal, including the "Racing Rules of Sailing") governing all BBYRA activities, classes, races or events (Racing, Education or Social) and certify that I am in compliance with the boating safety requirements of the State of Minnesota and that I have caused my boat and equipment to be properly registered, by either displaying the requisite license decals or carrying on my boat the proper registration papers. I also agree to abide to any rules, emergency orders or other regulations imposed by the State or Federal Government or by the BBYRA board in response to emergencies such as, but not limited to pandemic related regulations. I understand that it is my responsibility to adhere and/or enforce these rules/orders and that I am solely responsible for any breaches of said rules/orders. I further certify that I have liability insurance coverage (covering bodily injury and property damage) on my sailboat, that sailboat racing is within the scope of my insurance coverage (if I plan to race my sailboat in a BBYRA event), that my boat has all of the required equipment (including Coast Guard approved personal buoyancy devices), and that my boat and equipment have been properly maintained and they are safe to use in the sport of sailboat racing.

I give permission to the BBYRA to use any photographs of all persons listed on this application on its website or in its newsletter. Skipper is the person in charge of the boat, either the owner or the owner's designee.

Clarification of BBYRA Membership Fee Structure: Annual membership runs from May 1st of each year through April 30th of the following year. Each BBYRA membership is a family membership. For BBYRA purposes a family is one or more people living in the same household. There is also a per boat aspect to membership that a single family that wants to race two boats needs to purchase one racing membership for each boat.

Here are some examples of how the membership fee structure works in practice:

1. One couple pays for a single Basic membership which enables them both to crew on the same boat simultaneously and skipper the boat with the owner's permission.

2. One couple pays for a single Basic membership which enables them both to crew on separate boats simultaneously.

3. One family pays for a single Racing membership which enables the parent to race their boat while the child crews on another boat simultaneously.

4. One extended family (2 families) pays for 1 Racing membership and 1 Basic membership which enables them all to race on their boat simultaneously.
